O&A Cancellation Policy

We are so excited to service clients in the community at a larger capacity! As we transition we want to ensure the Cancellation policy is clear so that everyone can participate accordingly.

-If you cancel seven days in advance it is a “responsible cancellation,” less than 7-day notice for **any** reason is an “irresponsible cancellation.” Programs canceled with a less than 7-day notice are subject to the following consequences:

-Participant is still responsible for the full cost of the ticket/admission (if applicable to the event). -The first two (2) cancellations will result in a “Warning.” -The third cancellation, within a 3-month period, will result in “Suspension” from ALL LifeBridge programs for one (1) month.
