## Now Hiring Part-Time Positions

LifeBridge is accepting applications for part-time positions to support SPARK Club and LifeBridge Leaders Club. Spark is an after school enrichment program for kids who have a physical and/or intellectual disability. SPARK Club runs Monday-Thursday for students attending the Gateway Complex, located 1.5 miles from SLU. It includes fun activities, field trips, a healthy snack, and accessible transportation home provided by LifeBridge.

LifeBridge Leaders Club is an after school enrichment program that includes fun and interactive activities to develop social skills for success in the work place. Leaders Club is offered to students attending Nottingham CAJT High School and are preparing for or currently participating in the community work service program. The Leaders Club runs Tuesdays and Thursdays from 2p—4p.

Responsibilities include providing individualized support, monitoring safety, leading activities, participating in community field trips, and providing safe transportation home.

Applicants must pass a thorough background check, have reliable transportation, and complete CPR/First Aid training. Applicants must be able to work 2 out of the 4 days from 2:15pm-6:45pm for Spark Club and Tuesdays/Thursday for Leaders Club. Both programs run in conjunction with the St. Louis Public School's calendar. Experience working with children with disabilities is preferred but not required.
